



This is a **Vancouver Coastal Health** requirement for exhibitors who extensive on-site food preparation (chopping, frying, heating, etc.).

A Temporary Hand Washing Station consists of free-flowing water from a spout/spigot whereby hands can be washed at the same time, with liquid soap in a dispenser (not hand sanitizer), paper towels and a container for wastewater.

Ensure the water container is fitted with a spigot type tap rather than a push and hold button. The spigot arrangement needs to allow for hands-free running of the water.

Operators are responsible for maintaining proper water supplies and removing water from their booths.

All exhibitors may create a Temporary Hand Washing station by purchasing the elements at their local hardware store.
